POSITION: CAMP PROGRAM STAFF

TERM: June 29 to August 22, 2020. This position is a full time 8 week commitment.

Join our Scouts Canada Team of 'Camp Program Staff' delivering an exciting and highly interactive outdoor program. Our unique adventure and wilderness sessions inspire intrigue and motivate the campers through a "learn by doing" methodology. Our fun approach to the activities and everything we do at camp keeps things lively and entertaining. To succeed in this position you will need to truly enjoy the outdoors, enjoy working with youth, have a sense of adventure and enjoy having fun. Preference will be given to those taking post-secondary schooling.

Your primary responsibility will be program delivery however you will be required to assist with other camp duties as requested. Applicants must have Standard First Aid or better and must be available to take a canoe certification course, paid for by Scouting, prior to starting employment. Scouting experience is an asset but not required.

DUTIES:

The successful candidate will be responsible for:

- To deliver programs to the campers during the 8 weeks of Summer Camp.
- Ensure all programming is delivered in a safe manner.
- Prepare for sessions and ensure all supplies are ready to go prior to session start time.
- Expand the children's knowledge of the environment while teaching "Leave No Trace" camp ethics.
- Inspire friendships and acceptance through team building exercises.
- Enhance the child's self-esteem and confidence through positive reinforcement.
- Assist in the direction of planning sessions and attend all staff meetings.
- Direct all appropriate questions or concerns to the camp director.
- Foster an atmosphere of fun and create those cherished "at camp" memories for everyone.
- Help out with other camp tasks when available.
