Working as part of a team to assist with the preparation and delivery of assigned programs. Assist with coordination of program rotation. Ensure all equipment and materials are ready prior to program start times. Some previous cooking experience is necessary and Food Safe Certification would be an asset. The successful applicants will also be required to complete the Scouts Canada Screening and Training requirements.

Specifically, you will be responsible for:

- To deliver programs to the campers during the 7 weeks of Summer Camps.
- Ensure all programming is delivered in a safe manner.
- Assume responsibility for making sure you are cross trained in all program activities.
- Assist with daily campground safety inspection.
- Prepare for sessions and ensure all supplies are ready to go prior to session start time.
- Motivate and expand the children’s knowledge of the environment while teaching “Leave No Trace” camp ethics.
- Inspire friendships and acceptance through team building exercises.
- Enhance the child’s self-esteem and confidence through positive reinforcement.
- Assist in the direction of planning sessions and attend all staff meetings.
- Direct all appropriate questions or concerns to the camp director.
- Assist with the general camp clean up.
- Foster an atmosphere of fun and create those cherished “at camp” memories for everyone.
